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A WOMAN'S RIGHT TO KNOW

PHYSICIAN'S OBLIGATIONS

Except in the case of a medical emergency, not less than 24 hours prior to the performance of an abortion, the following information is to be provided to the woman by the physician who is to perform the abortion, or a referring physician, or an agent of either physician, by phone or in person:

- Name of the physician who will perform the abortion.
Medical risks associated with the particular abortion procedure to be employed.
Probable gestational age of the unborn child at the time the abortion is to be performed.
Medical risks associated with carrying the child to term
Availability of free ultrasound imaging and heart tone monitoring facilities/ locations.
Medical assistance benefits may be available for prenatal care, childbirth, and neo-natal care, and that the father is liable to assist in support of her child.
She has the option to review printed materials provided by the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, which include a Resource Directory and Information Booklet.

- A summary of the Informed Consent Law (OK law Title 63, Section 1-738.2).
Probable anatomical and physiological characteristics of the unborn child.
Photos/drawings and facts concerning the development of an unborn child at two-week gestational increments.
Methods of abortion procedures most commonly employed.
Medical risks commonly associated with the listed abortion procedures.
An overview of pregnancy and childbirth.
Medical risks commonly associated with carrying a child to term.
Possible detrimental psychological effects of abortion and of carrying a child to term.
Unborn Child Pain Awareness/Prevention Act Statement pursuant to Oklahoma law (Title 63 Section 1-738.10).
